Information

In the unusual situation that we don't find a suitable partner for you after you have fully booked your Summer 2:1 course, you will be upgraded to a 1:1 course for no extra fee.


Students on a Summer 2:1 course may **share a bedroom** with their partner.

Summer 2:1 courses are General English courses. If you have a specific individual requirement for your course e.g. exam preparation, advanced English, or private sports lessons, please book a 1:1 course.

Airport: Any UK airport

Transfers: Shared or individual transfers depending on location of teacher and flight time of partner – transfer fees will be advised with your teacher proposal

Excursions (14-21): Fees are included for all local excursions
2 weeks: 4 afternoons and 1 day trip; 3 weeks: 6 afternoons and 2 day trips

Information

A Young Learners course home tuition 1:1 course is for ages 10 - 17. Your child is carefully matched with their teacher and family. You can choose when you want to come (at any time of the year), how long you would like to stay, and the number of hours tuition per week.

Young Learners benefit from a home tuition course because we offer your child a course personally designed for their needs, with close supervision in a warm, comfortable home, with a caring, professional teacher.

Activities and excursions

Fees are included in all our Young Learners courses for all local excursions.

On a Young Learners course, your child will have a social programme tailored to their interests. Specially suited, fully supervised activities are undertaken with the teacher in the local area.

Visits to Local Places of Interest

Your teacher will be able to take you to visit local cities, where you will be able to do some sightseeing and souvenir shopping.

Depending on location, you will be able to visit famous British landmarks, beaches, museums country houses and castles.

Sports

If you enjoy sports, it may be possible for you to visit the local sports centre; where you can swim, play racquet sports with your partner or maybe even go rock climbing or try some water sports. You may also be able to hire a bike.

Please discuss this with your teacher and they will be happy to arrange sports activities in their local area. Please note that expensive sports like horse riding and golf can be arranged in advance for an additional fee.

Activities in the Local area

Your teacher will be able to let you know what activities are available in the local area. These may include a visit to the cinema or zoo, a game of bowling or mini golf or a visit to an arts and crafts centre.

Frequently asked Questions

Pre-Arrival Documents – Why Are They Important?

To ensure a smooth start, we require key documents before arrival. Please submit them via the Student Portal as soon as possible after booking your course.

- **Initial Assessment** – Helps the teacher prepare lessons tailored to the student's level. Without it, valuable lesson time may be lost to assessment.
- **Safeguarding Form** – Crucial for student welfare, covering medical conditions, allergies, emergency contacts, and permissions (e.g. going out unaccompanied). Parents should complete this.
- **Code of Conduct** – Outlines expectations for behaviour during the stay.

Without these documents, we cannot guarantee a well-prepared course. Please also look at your **2025 Student Handbook** on the student portal - this is packed full of useful information about your stay!

Your Stay

- **Course dates** – Standard schedule is Sunday to Saturday, but other start dates may be available.
- **Teachers** – Carefully selected, experienced, and fully trained to provide personalised tuition.
- **Accommodation** – Students live in their teacher's home with full board (meals included).
- **Clothing & essentials** – Pack comfortable clothes, a waterproof jacket, and sturdy shoes for excursions. A dictionary is useful!
- **Laundry & WiFi** – All homes provide washing facilities and free internet access.

Travel & Transfers

- **Why do young learners have to book an LLE transfer?** For safety and ease, all under-18s must use our transfer service. We provide a secure meet-and-greet and ensure students arrive safely at their teacher's home.
- **What does the transfer fee cover?** The fee reflects personalised service: a named driver, safe travel, luggage assistance, and 24/7 support.
- **Getting to your teacher's home** - We advise on the best airport and transport options.

Lessons & Study

- **Schedule** – Lessons start at around 9 am and run until lunchtime, with a break. Courses of 25+ hours have lessons in the afternoons.
- **Homework & self-study** – Expect around 1 hour per day. Watching English TV, reading, or practising conversation is encouraged.

Daily Life & Activities

- **Excursions & going out** – Students may only go out alone with written parental permission (via the Safeguarding Form).
- **Food** – Home-cooked meals by the teacher; dietary requirements can be catered for, please inform us in advance.
- **Phones & internet** – WiFi is available. To avoid roaming charges, use messaging apps and WiFi calling.
- **Smoking & vaping** – Not permitted for under-18s.

Health & Safety

- **Medical care** – All students from outside the UK have free travel insurance, covering emergency medical treatment. Teachers can arrange doctor visits if needed.
- **Safeguarding** – All teachers are trained to prioritise student safety.

Payments & Extra Costs

- **How to pay Living Learning English?** – Use Flywire for secure, international payments.
- **Spending money** – Students should bring money for personal expenses and souvenirs.
